2007 SCAPE Show Schedule

Time to finish those paintings of the Santa Barbara Botanic Garden by April 27 and Coal Oil Point Reserve, Santa Cruz Island, Santa Barbara County estuaries and islands, the Douglas Family Preserve and other City Parks for July. Happy Painting! Here's the latest news about our shows for 2007.

The image ingathering for paintings to be considered for the invitation and publicity for the "[Islands and Estuaries](#)" show will be Saturday, May 5 from 2:30 to 3:30 at Marjorie Palonen's home, 567 Para Grande Lane, in Montecito and across from Ellen Easton's Gallery. Pick up time is 4:30 to 5:30. These images should be of the beneficiaries, UCSB's Coal Oil Point Reserve and Santa Cruz Island Reserve or Santa Cruz Island from the mainland and may also be of other Santa Barbara estuaries and islands. Consideration will be given to artists who have not had an image on an invitation before. Images chosen will automatically be in the show and need to be for sale at the show.

The image ingathering for paintings to be considered for the invitation and publicity for the "[City Parks, Domestic and Wild](#)" exhibit will be on Saturday, May 19, at the Louis Lowry Davis Center, 1232 De La Vina. Drop paintings off from 9:30 to 11 a.m. and pick them up from 1 to 2 p.m. Consideration will be given to artists who have not had an image on an invitation before. Images chosen will automatically be in the show and need to be for sale at the show. These images should be of the Douglas Family Preserve and/or City Parks or parkland.

The Botanic Garden is gorgeous right now just in time to paint for the show with free admission to current SCAPE members. The Garden has graciously agreed to award a special SBBG Marcia Burttt Award at our show.

An outdoor weekend exhibit at the Botanic Garden featuring plein air paintings of Santa Barbara County with an emphasis on paintings created on site at the Botanic Garden. There will be \$500 of SCAPE prizes awarded and a special "Santa Barbara Botanic Garden, Marcia Burttt" award given out this year at the Botanic Garden Show! At this special show the artists receive 65% of the sales. Our show coincides with the grand opening ceremony of the Discovery Garden and a lot of visitors are expected. This event will coincide with the grand

opening ceremony of the Discovery Garden. SCAPE members will be given free access to the Botanic Garden to paint.

"City Parks - Domestic and Wild" - July 28-29, 11:00 - 6:00 - La Arcada Plaza, between the Library and Santa Barbara Museum of Art

Beneficiary: Friends of the Douglas Family Preserve/PARC Foundation.

The weekend exhibit will feature paintings of city and area parks, with an emphasis on the Douglas Family Preserve, including the plants, animals, and family pets that enjoy the park. This is SCAPE's annual event with entertainment and artist demonstrators.

Ingathering costs for each show are \$10 for one painting and \$25 for three. There is no limit to the number of paintings that may be juried into the exhibits.

Artists are invited to submit paintings in all styles and media, and collage or assemblage. We don't exhibit photographs or digital art. All paintings must be framed with wires on the back for hanging. The jurors will look for well-executed paintings that adhere to the theme of the exhibit. They will also consider the quality and appropriateness of framing.

There will be monetary and honorary awards given at each exhibit.

Artists whose paintings are selected for exhibits are expected to work at least three hours before or during the exhibit or pay \$40.

50% of sales will go to the artists, 40% will be donations to the exhibit's beneficiary and 10% will go to SCAPE. (Artists will receive 60% at the Botanic Garden show.)

Insurance on artwork submitted is the responsibility of the artist. Though care will be taken, SCAPE will not be responsible for damage or theft. If your work is seen at the exhibit and purchased after the exhibit by that buyer at your studio, please respect the terms of the show.
