We will carpool from Santa Barbara, arriving prior to 10:30, when we will meet with a staff member prior to entering the many exquisite gardens. There is a dining room for your lunch break. You are in for a treat of the gardens: Chinese, Children's, Botanical Conservatory, Desert, Herb, Rose, Shakespeare, Camellia, Australian, Palm, Jungle, Lilly Ponds, Subtropical.

You will also want to view the Library as Constable's great landscapes exhibit is running through 4/25. (FYI Thomas van Stein was inspired as a child to become an artist upon viewing Constable's clouds...and TVS is very good at clouds.)

SCAPE is going to Santa Cruz Island Reserve on Tuesday, April 17 departing 9:00 a.m. with Island Packers, 1691 Spinnaker Drive in Ventura, arriving on the island at 10 a.m. This trip is available to 13 people. We will depart the island on Friday, April 20 at 2:15 p.m. and return to Ventura at approximately 4:00 p.m.

Space has been reserved on Island Packers for our round trip transportation. The accommodations at the field station are 3 dorm rooms (4 beds each) and 2 private rooms with queen or double bed.

THIS MAKES IT SIMPLE: YOUR CHECK IS YOUR RESERVATION. MAKE CHECKS FOR \$120.00 PAYABLE TO "MARILYN GOODFIELD" AND SEND TO HER AT 3931 FOOTHILL ROAD, CARPINTERIA, CA 93013.

You will pay Island Packers \$55.00 at check-in separately for your round trip transportation to the island.

The total trip will be \$175, plus any food you bring for yourself.

The breakdown is as follows:

- o \$55 - round trip to the island aboard Island Packers
- o \$30 - round trip truck for you and your gear to

beach; there is a plaque marking the spot where the Japanese bombed the coastline in the 1940s and nice bathrooms. Paint on the beach or follow cliff path to the south with views to Sandpiper and coastline.

### March 11, 2006 SCAPE Second Saturday Paint-out at Ranch San Julian



Rancho San Julian is a 14,000 acre cattle ranch which specializes in holistic range management. It is from an original Spanish land grant with many old historic buildings and the original adobe. It is near Lompoc on the eastern side of the Bixby Ranch. Cameron Benson from the EDC put me in touch with one of the owners, Jim Poett. Anita Donohoe (a descendent of the De la Guerra family) was our host and shared much of the ranch history with us in front of Casa de San Julian (Dibblee and De la Guerra).

It was sunny and beautiful at 7:30 am, but very cold. We had thunder, lightning, some rain and even hail plus intermittent sunshine. Most of the artists painted tucked away under porch overhangs or in various outbuildings looking out. We met for lunch in the barn and some of us stayed
