"Handling the Figure in Landscape and Cityscape"

A five-day oil painting workshop for artists of all skill levels

Monday, October 24 through Friday afternoon,

Join acclaimed painter Randall Sexton and learn how to better incorporate the figure into landscape or cityscape. Work directly from the model in a studio setting and, later in the week, on location. During the first two days, poses will be brief to learn to use gesture and simplification; Randy will then take the class outdoors and set up the model in beach, park or café. The last half-day will be an indoor critique of all work done during the week.

Randall Sexton participates widely in contemporary California plein air events, winning awards at some of the most prestigious such as the Laguna Plein Air Painters annual summer event. Known for his bold and colorful plein air paintings of Northern California, Sexton also enjoys working in the studio. The direct and spontaneous nature of plein air painting influences all his paintings —still life, figurative, and studio work based on field studies and travels.

Highly sought as an instructor, he has a hands-on approach to teaching that involves sharing his technique and knowledge, yet focuses on the individual needs of each student. He has been leading workshops in the Bay Area since 1995. Randall holds a BFA from the University of Connecticut; he now teaches at the Academy of Art College in San Francisco. He exhibits with John Pence Gallery in San Francisco, Nancy Dodds in Carmel, Firethorn Gallery in Palm Springs and Fountainside Gallery in Wilmington, NC. His work has been featured in *Southwest Art* and *American Artist*.
