This show is a chance for artists to share a glimpse of a favorite subject using more intimate language. Your glimpse may be, for example, an open doorway, an ocean wave, a tree, or the compelling shape of a single boulder. This show is open to SCAPE members only, and will be judged by Gary Breitweiser, a well known Santa Barbara art dealer.

The exhibition will open [Wednesday, July 22](#) and the reception is on [Friday, July 26](#) from 4:00-7:00 p.m.

The show will be taken down Sunday, August 18 and work should be picked up that day before 6:00 p.m. At the time of sale, buyers will make a tax deductible donation of the other 50% to the environmental group of choice. Examples are the Land Trust for Santa Barbara County, the Environmental Defense Center, Friends of Santa Cruz Island, The Sierra Club, Friends of the Ellwood Coast, among many others.

Fiesta Finale Exhibition

A benefit for the Profant Foundation, which supports art and artists in our community, this small and exclusive show will call for work featuring Santa Barbara themes, particularly historic buildings or Fiesta paintings. Large paintings, beautifully framed, up to 40 inches wide including frame, will be sought by the juror selected by the Profant Foundation.

Ingathering and Exhibition Dates

[Thursday, August 1](#) from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at Marcia Burt Studio, 517 Laguna Street, Santa Barbara. Pick up all work between 12:00 and 1:00 p.m. the same day.

The show itself will be for one evening only, [Sunday, August 4](#), in the Mural Room of the Courthouse.

Artists will be expected to provide an easel, and to take their art in between 10 and 11 a.m. Sunday morning and pick up at the end of the evening. Entry fee for the show is \$5 per piece submitted. Due to the small size of the show, entry of only one piece per person is suggested. Thirty-three percent of the proceeds from sale of paintings goes to the Profant Foundation.
