Review of Third Annual La Arcada Show in May 2004

Our third SCAPE La Arcada Show May 15-16 was a huge success. More than 100 artists participated in the show juried by Southwest Art Magazine juror Bonnie Gangelhoff. A total of 232 paintings were accepted out of 282 entries. The following artists were given awards:

Best of Show (winner of Southwest Art Magazine ad): Chris Loizeaux, "Enter Flying," "One World," "The Meeting Place," Monoprint (Bonnie awarded all three paintings as a "body of work.")

First Prize: Joanne Benedict, "Gold Finch Staple," Watercolor

Second Prize: Jack Wilson, "Light Through The Pines," Watercolor

Third Prize: Shelly Johnson, "Louring Sky - Clark Refuge," mixed media

Honorable Mentions:

Linda Mutti, "At the Gap," pastel

Betty Little, "Ms. Raven 1," watercolor

Marguerite Costigan, "Oso Flaco IV: Marsh Wren," watercolor

Jane Sun, "Winter Splendor, Lake Los Carneros," pastel

Laurel Goerke, "Yellow Frog," watercolor

We were able to make a donation of \$5,421 to the Audubon Society, which represents 40% of the sales of 28 pieces.

The best part of our exhibit was the cooperation and enthusiastic participation of all the artists. Three people co-chaired the event. We want to especially thank people who worked more than the required four hours. Liz Gilmore oversaw the creation of the invitations and posters before she went to South America!
