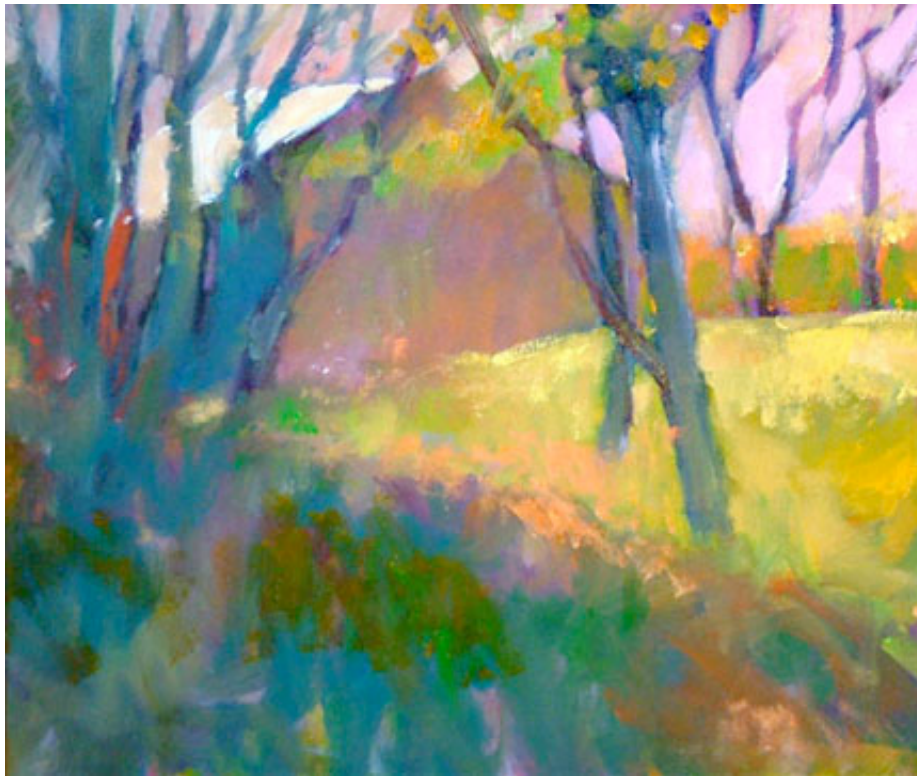

Nationally recognized painter, author, and teacher, Skip is renowned for his extraordinary work as a colorist. Skip regularly has his work included in books, magazines and national publications, and juries national and international exhibitions. Recently Skip received the High Winds Medal from the American Watercolor Society. He is the author of *Painting Light and Shadow in Watercolor* and is co-author and associate editor of *Watermedia Focus* and *The Palette* magazines.
