#### CALL TO ARTISTS PHOENIX of SANTA BARBARA EXHIBIT at Phoenix Mountain House

##### SCAPE Art Sale and Exhibit, "Art Along the Creek" to benefit PHOENIX of SANTA BARBARA

**WHEN:** Memorial Day Weekend, SUNDAY May 25th & MONDAY 26th, 11 am - 6 pm

**WHERE:** PHOENIX MOUNTAIN HOUSE: 37 Mountain Drive, Santa Barbara, CA. The exhibit will be held on the lower portion of the property, at the site of Phoenix's creek restoration project, at the corner of Mission Canyon Road and Mountain Drive. Artists are invited to submit paintings in all styles and media and collage or assemblage. We don't exhibit photographs or digital art. All paintings must be framed with wires on the back for hanging. The jurors will look for well-executed paintings that adhere to the theme of the exhibit. They will also consider the quality and appropriateness of framing. There will be monetary and honorary awards given.

Our theme is "ART ALONG THE CREEK": Restoring Land, Restoring Lives" We will welcome landscape, abstract, portrait and figurative images. The show will benefit Phoenix House's creek restoration project. There will be a special focus on landscapes depicting Mission Canyon, Mission Creek, and other creeks and land restoration sites, and on abstract, portrait, or figurative art depicting the theme of restoration. Special awards will be given in these categories.

Ingathering costs for each show are \$10 for one painting and \$25 for three. There is no limit to the number of paintings that may be juried into the exhibits.

Artists are invited to submit paintings in all styles and media, and collage or assemblage. We don't exhibit photographs or digital art. All paintings must be framed with wires on the back for hanging. The jurors will look for well-executed paintings that adhere to the theme of the exhibit. They will also

Special opportunity: Print sales! Anyone who submits one or more paintings will be able to submit up to six prints without paying an extra fee. Prints must be unframed, matted, and in a plastic sleeve. Artist's name, title, media, and price must be on back. Prints will not be hung, but will be displayed in a clearly marked print bin. The percentage to the artist will be 50%, the same as for paintings.

Special volunteer opportunities: In addition to the usual volunteer tasks, we will need special volunteers for this show. We will need people to pass out flyers to visitors to the Mission, to serve as parking attendants at the Rockwood parking lot (by Rocky Nook Park) and to set up easels and paint across the street from the Mission along the way to our show. We can also use volunteer musicians (non-amplified acoustic guitar, harp, flute, etc). There will be monetary and honorary awards given at each exhibit.

Artists whose paintings are selected for exhibits are expected to work at least three hours before or during the exhibit or pay \$40.

50% of sales will go to the artists, 40% will be donations to the exhibit's beneficiary and 10% will go to SCAPE. (Artists will receive 60% at the Botanic Garden show.)

Insurance on artwork submitted is the responsibility of the artist. Though care will be taken, SCAPE will not be responsible for damage or theft. If your work is seen at the exhibit and purchased after the exhibit by that buyer at your studio, please respect the terms of the show.
